vorzeichen gelten immer nur einmal vor der betreffenden note.

A: jeder klang ist sehr leise, jeder klang für sich.

B: insgesamt leise.

im letzten verklingen eines klanges den nächsten bereits spielen, dabei die taste des vorhergegangenen noch halten, bis dieser ganz verklungen ist.

vor einem stillbleiben verklingt der klang.

C: eher kurze, kräftige impulse: mp/mf. die ober- bzw. unteroktave stumm drücken.

D: insgesamt leise und langsam.

E: insgesamt leise.

jeder klang für sich: wie in A.

now and then there sometime might be a standstill in every piece.
accidentals only apply once before the respective note.

A: each sound very soft, each sound for itself.

B: on the whole soft.

play the next sound during the last decay of the preceding sound. keep
the key of the last note down until the full disappearance.
a sound decays before a standstill.

C: rather short and strong impulses: mp/mf. mute pressure of the key
in the higher or lower octave.

D: on the whole soft and slow.

E: on the whole soft.








