gebracht („luftgeräusch“).

◇————— : ein äolischer klang auf einem atembogen.

 : drei äolische klänge auf einem atembogen (usw.).

 : etliche male wiederholen.


 : eine weile innehalten.


 : audible breath into the flute. exhale  /  
inhale  .


• ————— : sing the tone into the flute – without sound of the  
flute; rather middle register, free pitch.

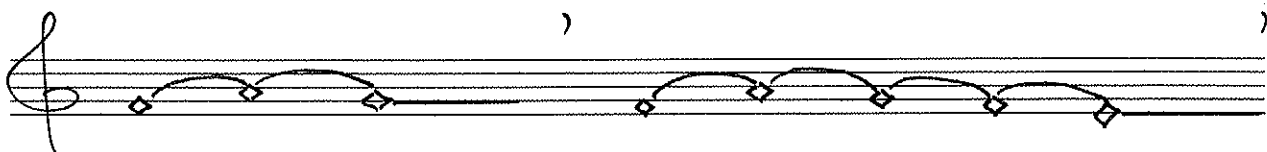
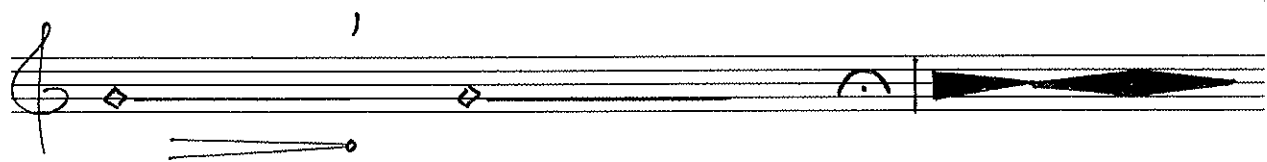
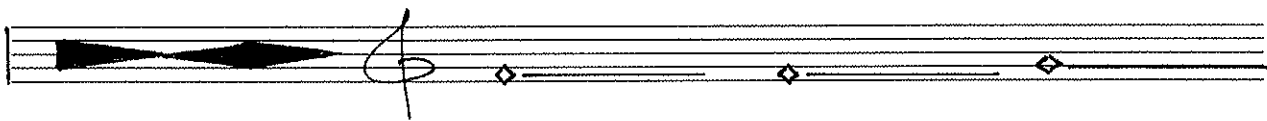
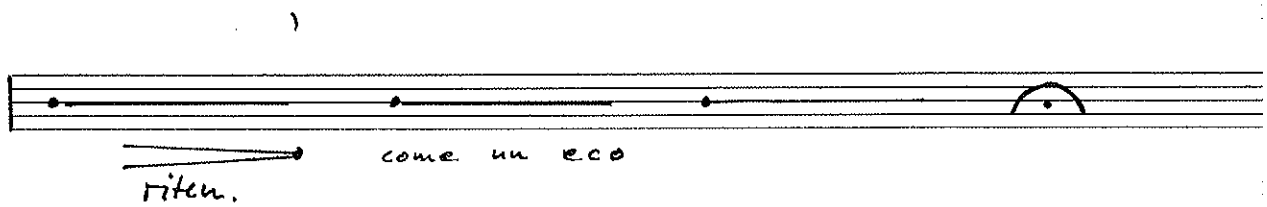
◇ : aeolian sound. the flute resonates with the air that  
is blown over the embouchure hole (“air sound“).

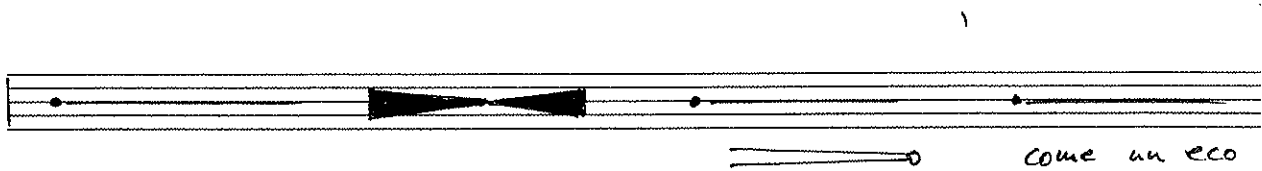
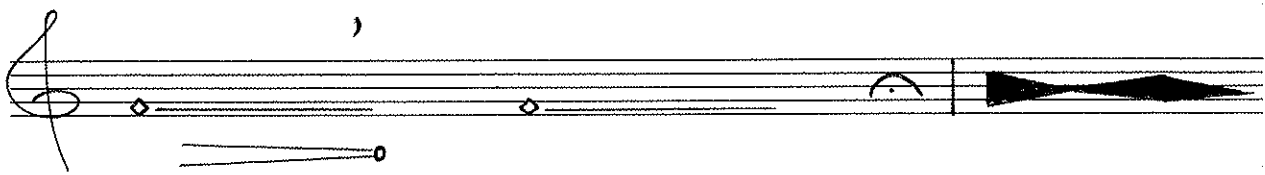
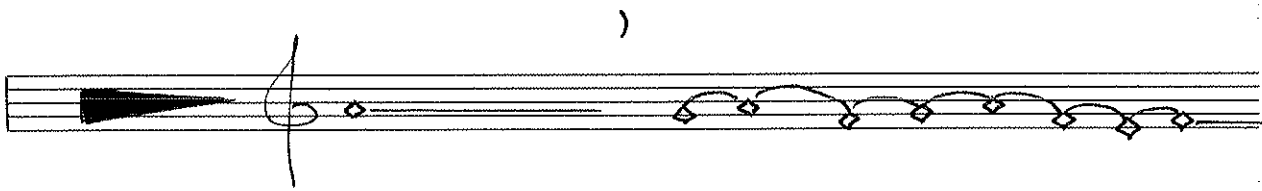
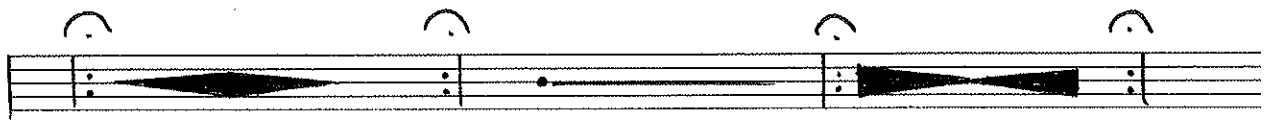
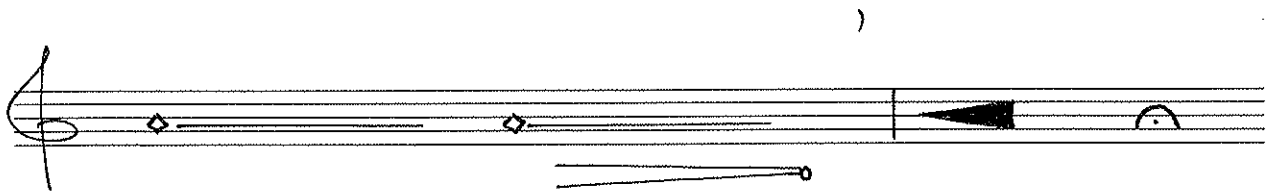
◇————— : one aeolian sound on one breath.

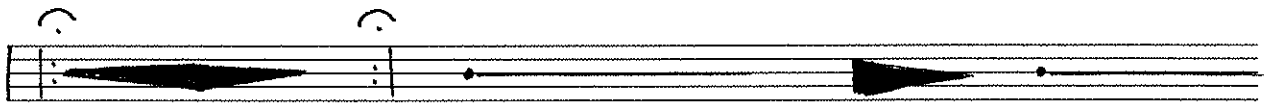
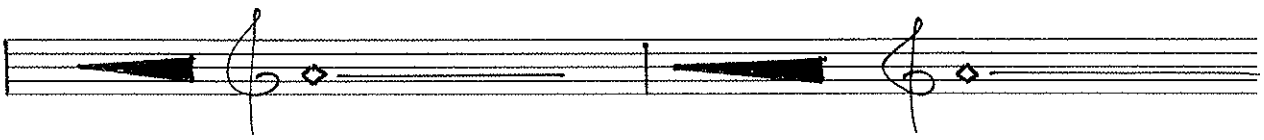
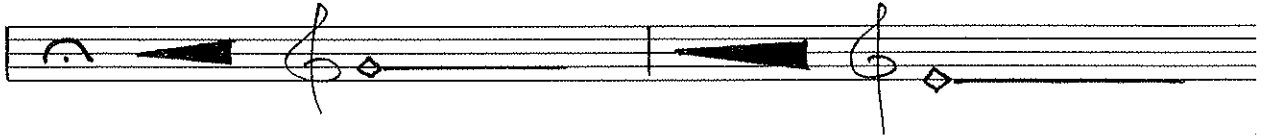
 : three aeolian sounds on one breath (et cetera).

 : stay for a moment.

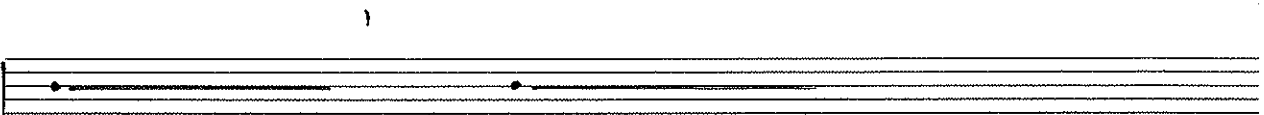
