dauer: 8 viertel (viertel = etwa 54 MM).

● : der ton wird angeschlagen.

— : der ton wird nicht angeschlagen.

insgesamt leise.

keep the right pedal down all the time.

choose a two-tone sound.

duration: 8 quarter notes (quarter = about 54 MM).

● : strike the key.

— : do not strike the key.

on the whole soft.

das rechte pedal bleibt die ganze zeit über niedergedrückt.  
der anfangsklang ist frei zu wählen, ab da in der gegebenen  
reihenfolge weiterspielen. klänge können wiederholt /  
ausgelassen werden.  
vorzeichen gelten jeweils für die betreffende note.  
klänge dürfen einander überlappen.  
zwischen klängen kann es auch sehr lange still bleiben.  
insgesamt leise.  
den höheren klang immer etwas lauter spielen (mp) als den  
tieferen (p).

keep the right pedal down all the time.  
choose the first sound freely, then on play in the given order.  
sounds may be repeated / omitted.  
key signatures count for the single note.  
sounds may overlap.  
it might remain silent for a long time between two sounds.  
on the whole soft.  
play the higher sound a bit louder (mp) than the lower one (p).

● : der ton wird angeschlagen.

○ : die taste wird stumm gedrückt. der ton kann vereinzelt noch einmal ansprechen.

insgesamt leise.

keep the right pedal down all the time.

choose a two-tone sound (look I).

duration: 4 quarter notes (quarter = 60 MM).

● : strike the key.

— : do not strike the key.

○ : press down the key mutely. it is possible that the sound occasionally appears.

on the whole soft.
