bambus

ein röhrengeläut aus bambusröhren, frei aufgehängt:

das geläut langsam bewegen. wie von einem stillen windzug bewegt, leise – während der angegebenen zeit.

zwei unterschiedlich klingende steinpaare

kreuz: gegeneinander schlagen (eher leise).

kreis: aneinander reiben.

kreis mit kreuz: gegeneinander schlagen, gleich darauf reiben.

fermate: während der angegebenen zeit.

fellinstrument

kreis: von hand streichen, langsame kreisbewegungen, leise.

kreuz: leise (mit finger) klopfen.

stimme

ein ton (bei dem einmal gewählten ton bleiben), leise.

kreis: atem frei strömen lassen, bis der ton verklungen ist.

aussprache: wie „ball“ (engl.).

endungen: p, t, k.

m: summen.

dauer: 60 minuten.

bamboo

bells of bamboo, pending freely:

move the bells slowly. the bells move quietly and calmly as if a soft wind stream would touch them – during the indicated time.

two pairs of stones – sounding differently

cross: clap towards each other (rather softly).

circle: rub them.

circle with cross: at first clap the stones, then rub them.

fermata: during the indicated time.

skin

circle: strike with your hand, slow circular motions, softly.

cross: tap softly (with your finger).

voice

one single sound (keep the sound all the time), sing softly.

circle: free stream of breath, until the sound decays.

pronunciation: like “ball”.

suffixes: p, t, k.

m: humming.

duration: 60 minutes.
