participants:

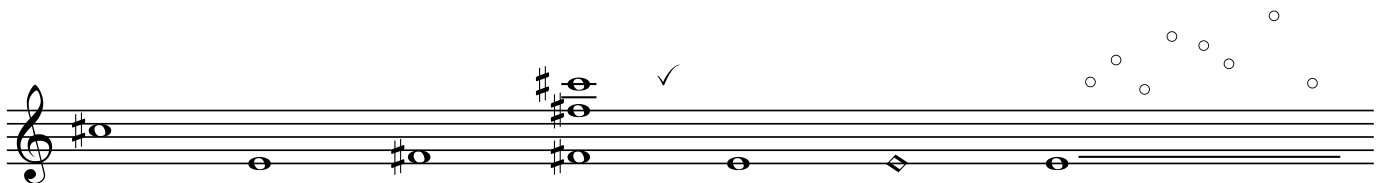
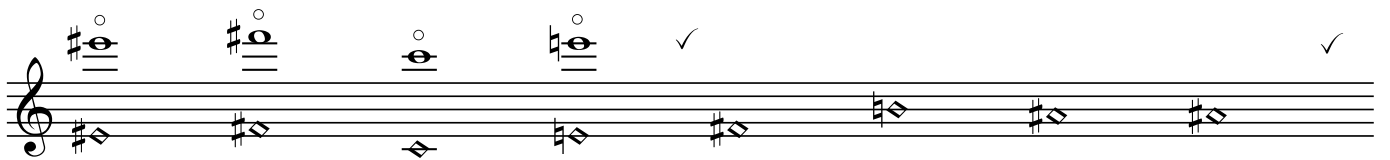
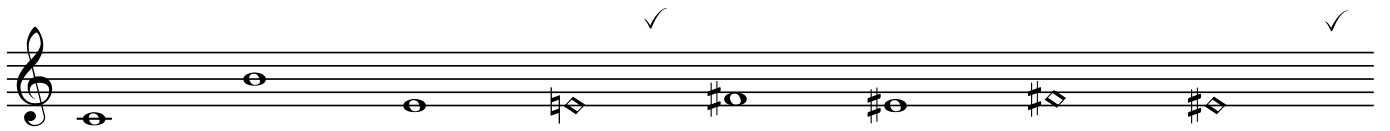
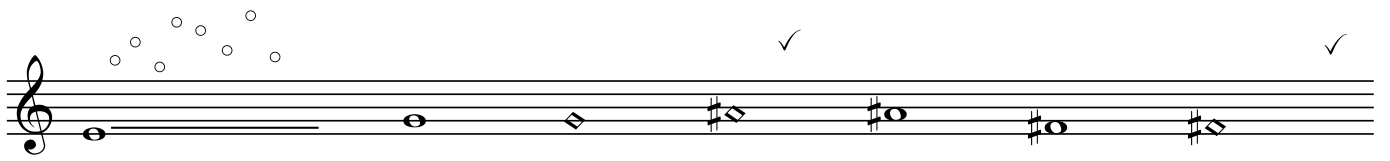
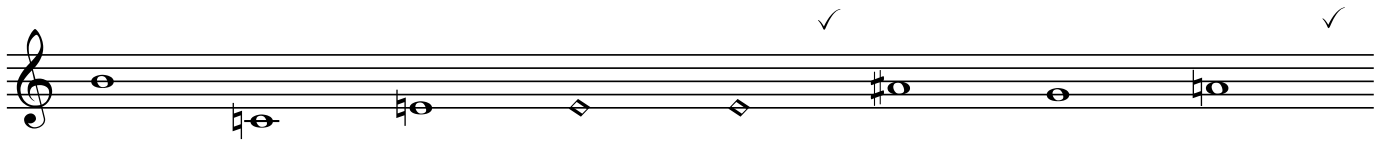
