All harmonics are natural, but the string is notated as a stopped note to facilitate the rhythmic convention above.

At least 6 minutes, perhaps 2 hours, maybe from sunrise to sundown.

Thoughts on the Piece

The subject of all photography, really, is light and space: all we have is the space and light left to us in the places we occupy. In the midst of a global pandemic, be it for shelter or convenience, we become intimately familiar with our idea of "place" and what that might mean in this context. 


